Grade conversion	
Each semester is concluded with an evaluation period after which the results are published. Students can download a digital copy of the results sheet themselves via their individual student file. ENSAPL uses the customary French grade point system. Study results are graded on a scale from 0 to 20, meaning :	
20 to 18 : excellent A+	A grade of 16 or 17 is awarded very sparingly, a grade of 19 or 20 is exceptional. The average grading for examination would be 10/20. Most of the marks are between 10/20 to 12 /20. 14 /20 is an excellent mark for the studio project.
17- 16 : very good A	
15-14 : good B	
12-13 : satisfactory C	
11: sufficient D	
10: is the passing grade E	
9 : insufficient F	Students have second exam chance in case of a fail. The resit exam is organized at the end of each semester . There is no second examination opportunity for practical courses.
